



If you are a UK taxpayer, using Gift Aid means that for every pound that you give the charity gets an extra 28p from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation to go further. Gift Aid allows the charity to reclaim the basic rate of income tax you have paid on the donation. What you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount the charity will claim in the tax year.
